



GUIDELINES FOR ePOSTER DISPLAYS

GENERAL INFORMATION

The ePoster display offers a valuable opportunity to share your work to an international audience throughout the duration of the ESPEN Congress. Your ePoster will be accessible via search function at all stations within the designated ePoster area.

The high-definition digital screens will showcase your ePoster in a professional and interactive setting, effectively highlighting your data and results. All attendees are invited to browse the ePosters during scheduled break times.

Please note:

No specific time slots are assigned for ePoster displays. However, we strongly encourage presenters to make use of our “Meet-the-poster-presenters” function to schedule meetings with interested delegates and discuss their research. Information on how to use this feature will be shared at a later stage.

ePOSTER DESIGN

- It is mandatory to indicate your new abstract number in the upper right corner of the poster
- Don't overload your poster. Remember, you are not writing an article
- Seek simplicity, keep text to a minimum and avoid redundancies
- ESPEN is keen to adopt new ways of poster presentation and design. We thus encourage our ePoster presenters to refer to the following article and guidelines when preparing their poster

- QR codes linking to scientific content or handouts can be included and may facilitate future research communication to your interested readers.
 - Presenters may upload optional supporting material to accompany their ePoster. This may include an audio (MP3) or video recording (MP4, with a max. video size of 500 MB) intended to provide additional context for the ePoster content. The inclusion of such material is optional but recommended.

ePOSTER SPECIFICATIONS

- The ePoster file should be **1 single page**
- Orientation: **16:9 Portrait**
- File format: **PDF**
- File size: **3MB maximum**

ePOSTER UPLOAD

You will receive an email including the link to the online platform to upload your ePoster.

- Upload portal opens **end-June 2026**
- Upload portal closes **5 September 2026**
- You will receive a unique upload link via email. If you do not receive it by 1 July 2026, please contact us.

ePoster uploads will not be accepted onsite - please ensure your ePoster is submitted before the deadline.
