

Registration Terms and Conditions

Payment

All costs referred to are in Euros (€) and include 21% Dutch VAT. All payments must be made in Euros; no other currency will be accepted. Full payment is due for the registration fees. Registrations are only confirmed once the required payment has been received.

Payment by credit card

The online registration platform is a secured site on which you can pay by credit card. Please note that VISA, Eurocard/MasterCard and AMEX are the only credit cards accepted. Upon completion of the online registration process, you will receive a paid invoice (receipt) by email.

Payment by bank transfer

Should you select to pay by bank transfer, upon completion of the online registration process, you will receive an outstanding invoice for your registration fee by email. This invoice includes all payment instructions as well as your registration number to mention as reference of the payment. Upon receipt of your payment in full, you will receive a registration confirmation by email. Please note that payment by bank transfer is only accepted until 22 May 2023.

Only digital versions of invoices (PDF) will be sent to delegates upon completion of the online registration. The invoice will be issued using the contact details provided during the online registration process so please make sure you have provided us with the correct information.

After you have registered via the online registration form and we have received your payment, you will receive a written confirmation by email.

Cancellation of registration

Any cancellations must be sent in writing to the ICEM Secretariat: <u>icem2023@wearemci.com</u>. The following cancellation fees apply:

- In case of cancellation **before or on 13 March 2023 (23:59 CET)**, the registration fee will be refunded minus a handling fee of EUR 50.
- In case of cancellation from 14 March until 22 May 2023 (23:59 CEST), 50% of the registration fee will be refunded.
- As of 23 May 2023, the registration fee will not be refunded for cancellations or no-shows.

Please note that any refunds due will be processed within 30 days after the Conference.

Name change
